What is a Digital Library?

It is a service where users may borrow and return digital books through compatible devices connected to the internet such as their computer, iPad, iPhone and android smartphones etc. It is a 24 hour service which can be used at any time.

Eligibility

Holders of the Hamamatsu Public Library card living in Hamamatsu, or commute to the City for work / school.

*Those that do not have a card can register for the library card and use the service from noon the following day after registration.

How Do I Login?

User ID: Hamamatsu Public Library User Number

Initial Password: Date of Birth (Western Calendar: 8 numbers)

(E.g. if your D.O.B was April 1, 1999, the password would be 19990401.)

* You can change the initial password after you login in.

Useful Features

- You can change the font size.
- You can change the direction of the writing from horizontal to vertical and vice versa.
- You can automatically turn pages.
- It has bookmarks and memo features.

*Certain features may not be available depending on the book and your device.

*You cannot duplicate or print out books.

How Can I Do This?

Log In

1. Access the Hamamatsu Digital Library (URL: <https://www.d-library.jp/hamamatsu/>)

You can also access it through the Hamamatsu Public Library Website.

*Click on the [Hamamatsu Digital Library] button on the Hamamatsu Public Library Website.

2. Enter your [User Number] and [Password] then log in.

Borrow/ Read / Return

Checkout Limit: Up to 3 Books Lending Period: 15 days

1. Search for the book(s) you want to read and click the [BORROW] button. If you have already taken out 3 books, the button will not work.

2. If you click the [READ] button, the digital book will appear on the screen.

*It may take some time from when you push the read button to when the book to appears on screen.

3. You can return the books that you have finished reading by pushing the [RETURN] button.

The book will automatically be returned when the loan period is over.

* You can lengthen the loan period if there are no reservations.

Reservations

Reservation Limit: Up to 3 books

Digital books you want to borrow that are currently out on loan can be reserved.

* You cannot reserve by email.

Reading without Checking Out

You can read material(s) which have the [READ] button instead of the [BORROW] button. Up to 3 books will not be included as part of checkout limit.
